EDSE 5374 - Educational and Psychological Measurement and Evaluation

A. MAJOR COURSE DESCRIPTION/REQUIREMENT

Diagnostic and instructional assessment of individuals with disabilities for collaborative education decision-making. Selection and administration of measures for comprehensive evaluation of individuals within their environments. A minimum of 15 hours of field experience is required.

B. LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, the student will:

- 1. Understand and apply knowledge of the purpose, philosophy, and legal foundations of evaluation.
- 2. Understand and apply knowledge of ethical and professional practices, roles and responsibilities.
- 3. Demonstrate knowledge and skills using descriptive statistics, reliability, validity and norm-referenced testing as it applies to assessment in special education.
- 4. Identify eligibility criteria and procedures for identifying students with disabilities.
- 5. Demonstrate skills in collection, maintenance, and dissemination of evaluation records, including collaboration among stakeholders.
- Demonstrate skills in selection, administration, and interpretation of individual standardized tests and informal assessments.
- 7. Use evaluation data for instructional decision-making and individual program planning.
- 8. Review the essentials of cross battery assessments and their effective integration into evaluation reports.
- 9. Discuss key issues regarding ethnic, cultural, and linguistic differences among students and its relevancy to the assessment process.
- Demonstrate skills necessary for scheduling, time management, organization, and professional advancement.
