GRAD is a thesis continuation course for Master's students who are not able to complete their thesis after enrolling in the second thesis course (WATR 5306).

As per the University's Catalog, the thesis requires 6 semester credit hours of grades, the first 3 semester credit hours consisting of a proposal, and the last 3 semester credit hours consisting of a thesis. The student should be enrolled in 5306 during semesters or summer terms when the student receives supervision from the research advisor or thesis committee or receives a research stipend. Students who complete two semesters of thesis and need to continue in a thesis course can choose to enroll in GRAD 5101, a thesis continuation course.
